Vaccines

Importance

As colder months near, the risk of illnesses like the flu, COVID-19, and RSV increases. We urge you to get vaccinated to protect yourself and others, especially vulnerable groups like older adults, children, and those with health issues.

1. Flu Vaccine

The annual flu shot is updated to target common strains, reducing personal risk and virus spread.

2. COVID-19 Vaccine

COVID-19 remains a threat, especially with new variants. Staying up to date with boosters helps prevent severe illness and hospitalization.

3. RSV Vaccine

RSV poses a risk to infants, older adults, and those with chronic conditions. New vaccines for older adults and pregnant women offer crucial protection.

Though no vaccine is 100% effective, they significantly reduce illness severity and complications, protecting you and others, especially the vulnerable.
