Lung Cancer Awareness: "It Started With..."



The NHS South East London Cancer Alliance (SELCA) has launched its "It Started With..." campaign to help people recognise early signs of lung cancer and encourage anyone with concerns to speak to their GP. Lung cancer can present differently for everyone, making awareness of symptoms essential.

Key symptoms include a new or persistent cough, breathlessness, a hoarse voice, chest or shoulder pain, repeated chest infections, coughing up blood-stained phlegm, unexplained weight loss, loss of appetite, or ongoing fatigue. These signs can be easy to overlook, but if they're new or unusual for you, it's important to get checked. Early detection greatly improves treatment outcomes.

You may see campaign messaging across social media and local advertising. We encourage you to stay aware of the symptoms and contact us if you have any concerns — speaking up early can make a real difference.

Flu season is here, and we're working hard to protect our community. We've already vaccinated many eligible patients and still have plenty of flu jabs available. If you haven't had your flu vaccine and fall into one of these groups, please contact reception or book with our nurse:

- Aged 50 or over
- In an 'at-risk group'
- A carer

We're also offering flu immunisation for children aged 2 and 3 via a quick, painless nasal spray.
